We use a variety of methods to develop and make judgments on the whole child including their key competencies; friendships; values; peer relationships and health & wellbeing. The whole school is using Te Whare Tapa Wha- which looks at the 4 pillars that make a whole person being physical, emotional, social & spiritual health.

The Year 8's will also be trialling an MOE programme on monitoring well being through a digital platform this term. It is called Goodspace, & will allow students to log in & self monitor how they are feeling.
