Principal's Message,

Kia ora koutou,

It's been really fantastic to see all of the learning that our students have been doing this week. I've been blown away by the pride that is being shown by our learners, when they show me their work and talk about what they are doing in class. Walking around the school this week I've seen students learning about seeds, working in the gardens, doing imaginative writing, using digital technologies, learning swimming skills and creating amazing art. Students have shown me their maths work, which for our Room 1 students has included addition and subtraction.

On Monday, our year 3 - 8 students went to a Rodney Rural Schools Cricket Day at Centennial Park. These opportunities to take part in education outside the classroom add so much to students' learning experience at primary school. I had lots of positive feedback from teachers and parents about the way our tamariki behaved at the park. Well done everyone.

The end of the term is just a couple of weeks away. Please note that, like most schools in New Zealand, the first day back at school will be Wednesday, April 26. This is the day after ANZAC Day. Monday the 24th of April will be a teacher only day. Our teaching staff will spend the day learning about the 'Refreshed', NZ Curriculum, and planning for the roll out of Aotearoa New Zealand Histories, as part of the Social Sciences Curriculum.
