Principal's Message

Kia ora koutou.

We are really excited to be getting back to our beautiful Nature Classroom next week. Our teaching staff have done a visit, and have met with Mrs Jackson to get all organised for our learning activities. There are two big factors that will make it easier to go to the Nature Classroom this year; the school van, and changes to the adult to child ratios when we are there. Instead of having a fixed ratio of 1 adult to 4 students, like past years, we are now putting more emphasis on the safety planning prior to our trips. This will enable us to tailor our adult supervision to meet the needs of the group visiting the bush block.

Tomarata staff have been discussing our ideas about how we can deliver different aspects of the curriculum while we are at the Nature Classroom. Art, science, history, writing, reading, technology, te reo Maori, mathematics etc, can all be explored in this unique setting. We are so lucky to have our Nature Classroom, and when I last spoke with Earl Barnes, the owner of the land, he said that his wife, Marie would be so thrilled to have us there as much as possible.

Room 1 is going along for the morning next Friday. I will be driving them there in our lovely new van.

This week we had another Garden to Table session with our students in their house groups. This approach enables our student leaders to work alongside our younger students, which is great to see. It gives our house groups a real sense of purpose. We harvested some apples from our orchard, as well as some very tasty bananas. As well as this, house groups are giving some thought to designing some new signage for around our school and garden areas.

A number of year 4 to 8 students are off to the Rodney Rural Schools Swimming Competition tomorrow. They are either being taken by parents to the pool at Rodney College, or they are going from Tomarata School in the school van. Let's hope for a nice warm day. Thank you to the parent helpers.
