Firstly, I'd like to apologise for there being no newsletter for the past 2 weeks.

Last week I was away at the Tai Tokerau Principals' Federation conference at Waitangi. It was a chance to meet with other principals, and stay up to date on a number of new initiatives and measures being implemented by our new government.

There were also a number of speakers, including Nathan Mikaere-Wallace, who gave a talk on neuroscience, and learning. The most powerful message that he had was that learning can only take place when children feel safe, cared for, and understood by the adults in their lives. He also emphasised the importance of laughter, music and movement at school, in order for learning to take place, because we learn best when we enjoy ourselves.

Another highlight was the presentation given by Mike Allsop, a New Zealander who has climbed Mt Everest, as well as run 7 marathons on 7 continents, in 7 days. He was a very inspirational presenter.
